



Experience in the environment and climate change programme

Today, it is impossible to talk about agricultural development without considering environmental factors. Protecting the environment and reducing the negative effects of climate change are prerequisites for the successful development of agriculture or food security. For more than 15 years, ERB has had extensive experience in environmental protection and climate change in the provinces of Bubanza, Bururi, Makamba, Cibitoke, Bujumbura Rural, Rutana, Ruyigi, Kayanza and Ngozi. The main achievements over the last five years (2018-2023) are as follows :

A

Development of at least 950,000 km of catchment areas

B

Production and planting of at least 21,000,000 fruit, forest and agro-forestry seedlings, as well as bamboo plants to protect river banks.

C

Training 900 households in the province of Cibitoke (Rugombo commune) in the Community Disaster Risk Management approach.

D

Training 1,500 households in rainwater conservation

E

Training 1800 households in the use of improved cooking stoves

Contribution to the protection of the Vyanda park in Bururi province
